Refund/Transfer Request

Refunds: If you request to withdraw from a camp at least 2 weeks or more before the camp starts, a refund will be issued, minus a \$10 refund fee. A refund request less than two weeks before the camp begins will not be approved.

Transfers: If you request to transfer from one camp to another at least two weeks before the camp starts, the transfer will be processed (if space is available). No transfer requests will be permitted if the request is made less than two weeks before the camp starts.
