In an effort to showcase all that the City of San Carlos is doing to promote environmental sustainability and the services and options available to the community, more than 25 vendors will be on hand to provide information on eco-conscious topics including electric vehicles, energy efficiency, indoor and outdoor water conservation, waste reduction, and home improvement financing. Entertainment will be provided by the Berkeley-based children's band Octopretzel, from 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. at the stage, followed by comments from Mayor Cameron Johnson beginning at 12:30 p.m. A raffle for eco-friendly prizes will also be held and the City of San Carlos booth will be distributing complimentary reusable, recyclable shopping totes, while supplies last.

"I look forward to the City's first Earth Day celebration," said Mayor Johnson "This is a great opportunity for the community to come together and learn about sustainable changes that can be made at home, such as installing water-efficient landscaping, using LED light bulbs, or purchasing an electric vehicle.
